Persuasive Platform Speech (from NCFCA)

Persuasive Speech is an original platform speech that influences the audience to consider a particular point of view or course of action.

- General Speech Rules and Script Rules must be followed in addition to these Event Rules.
- 2. Speech time is limited to a 10-minute maximum.
- 3. An original work must be presented. Original indicates that the speech is scripted word-for-word by the speaker.
- 4. Characterization may comprise up to 150 total words in the speech.

 Characterization refers to acting or speaking in a manner other than that of the speaker. Direct quotations may comprise up to 350 words of the total words in the speech.
- 5. Sources for supporting material must be verbally mentioned in the speech, parenthetically cited in the script, and listed on the Works Cited page.
 - Supporting material includes direct quotations, specific information, or another person's research, theories, or ideas.
 - Common knowledge that is known to most people does not need to be cited in any way.
- 6. Visual aids may not be used. Visual aids are items used to enhance the speech.
